In addition to certifying basic skills attainment, CASAS measures learner progress on a standardized scale that ranges from the lowest literacy skills to high school exit and transition to post-secondary education and training.

In 2010, we completely renovated the property and added 5 beds due to increased need. The underlying philosophy of the house is to foster individual accountability and responsibility and to encourage and support our clients through the continuum of care we feel is necessary for true recovery from substance abuse.

The criteria for admission include completion of detoxification or residential services and a commitment to sustain aftercare activities. There are specific rules designed to instill structure and discipline in the recovery process. Our transitional house is a step down from the services provided at our level III.1 halfway house, but clients must remain engaged with our main house and meet weekly with the case manager or executive director to monitor progress. The Fouse Center is a 10-bed facility located in Glen Burnie that serves as a transitional shelter for men in recovery from substance abuse or dependency. The Fouse Center program requires that residents attend AA and/or NA meetings to address substance abuse. Each resident must also attend individual counseling sessions with a mental health or substance abuse counselor. Efforts are made to link residents with healthcare providers to address medical and mental health issues. Each resident is required to perform daily chores, gain employment and make deposits to a savings account for future housing. The Fouse Center program is designed for residents to learn responsibility, maintain sobriety, and prepare for a drug-free, productive future.

If accepted into our program you will not be allowed to work for the first 30 days, during which time you will be indoctrinated into our program.
